




- Varsity games against Lin-Wood have been canceled due to rain.


- JV games against White Mtns. have been POSTPONED to May 27th. JV Practices will be TBA



Please wash and/or sanitize your hands frequently.

When students are in controlled settings (classrooms), we need to make sure masks are being worn properly, up over the nose and under the chin, that there are <u>3 feet</u> or more between them (with the goal of 6 feet). Don't huddle together, don't look over each other's shoulders, don't even partially remove your mask.



Please remember to avoid physical contact with other people such as hugs, high fives & handshaking.

Please input your temperatures into Powerschool first thing in the morning.

When in non-controlled settings, lunch, mask breaks, where masks are off, the State expectation continues to be 6 feet or more between students. Students <u>must</u> sit in the designated seats in the café and not move the Plexiglas dividers. Mask breaks need to spread out to the bus loop or King's Plain if students can't meet the 6-foot requirement while in front of the building.
