

A healthy supply of disposable diapers can cost \$80-\$100 per month per child. Many families in our community are struggling financially. Please help.



What is Red Ribbon Week?

Red Ribbon Week was created in 1985 after the death of DEA agent Enrique "Kiki" Camarena, who was murdered by drug traffickers that he was investigating in Mexico. During this week people wear ribbons to recognize the sacrifice of DEA agents and the thousands of people who lose their lives to substance misuse every year. Red Ribbon Week is the nation's oldest and largest drug prevention program and is celebrated from October 23-31
